A new term 'HMD-analysis' that reflects the essence of the suggested method has been introduced. The author gives definitions and characteristics of the three components of the HMD-analysis method: 'H'-group - high stock level, 'M'-group - medium stock level, and 'D'-group - down stock level. A step-by-step algorithm of the analysis of a retail establishment assortment based on this method has been given. The subdivision of groups of the assortment of goods is done according to the correlation coefficient of Charles Spearman.
