THE PRINCIPLES OF MEDIATION AS A LEGAL INSTITUTE: THEORETICAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

The present article is devoted to the analysis of the principles of mediation representing the certain legal category acting as a link between theoretical and legal interpretations of mediation, expressing essence of mediation, opening and concretizing his general concept.

Key words: mediation, legal principles, legal conflict, justice, legality, confidentiality, equality.

The dialectic method used in work allowed to consider the principles of mediation as all-legal category, to reveal elements in the content of the principles of mediation, to compare their theoretical understanding and practical application, to define the general tendencies in the course of realization. The structurally functional method was used at creation of system of the principles of mediation and justification of a role of each of them. The analysis of the principles of mediation allowed to draw a conclusion that the principles predetermine further development of mediation, representing a basis of self-regulation of intermediary activity. Besides, allocation of the principles allows to individualize mediation as an independent look out of - and jurisdictional activity, to define a qualitative originality of rules of its organization, carrying out and features of a legal regulation in comparison with jurisdictional ways of permission of the legal conflicts. All this causes need of definition, systematization and studying of the principles of mediation. Eventually and further development of all-legal institute of mediation the principles, most likely, will be supplemented, change, unified and to be concretized.

Mediation, being legislatively settled procedure, submits to the fundamental beginnings of its carrying out, that is the principles. The principle of mediation is a scientific or moral beginning, the basis, the rule, a basis from which do not recede when holding a procedure of mediation. The analysis of the principles of mediation as all-legal institute allows to allocate the following classifications: the principles fixing features of mediation, and also the status of the parties (the coordination principles): principle of impartiality of the intermediary; principle of independence of the intermediary. These

principles find the realization in mediation at permission of the legal conflicts in different branches of the right (civil, family, labor, etc.); the principles fixing the procedure of mediation, an order of its carrying out (the adjusting principles): principle of voluntariness; principle of independence of the parties; principle of equality of the parties. The specified principles of mediation as all-legal institute are characteristic both of mediation in the economic sphere, and of mediation at permission of the legal conflicts. Besides, it is necessary to refer to this group of the principles also the principle of confidentiality which find the realization in mediation at permission of the legal conflicts in different branches of the right (civil, family, labor, etc.).

Not all households have the opportunity to set aside savings, however, households save some of their disposable income, prefer to invest it into a Deposit in a commercial Bank or to enter the housing market for the purchase of real estate. To invest their savings in buying property prefers most households. However, few have a sufficient level of total income for investments of this kind. For this reason, many households do not save cash and use all their disposable income on final consumption or saving some of their disposable income and postpone it until when the size of the savings will be sufficient to enter the housing market for the purchase of real estate.
