AS A RESULT OF MODERNIZATION OF HEALTH CARE**

In the article the analysis of reforming the provision of specialized ophthalmologic medical care in the system of mandatory medical insurance in the Leningrad region, which had a significant impact on the maintenance of its economic availability.

*Key words:* cataract, financing medical care, fees, mandatory medical insurance, eye care specialized medical care ophthalmologist.

The Problem of limiting the availability and quality ophthalmic medical care remains one of the leading national healthcare. Especially acute in the provision of specialized ophthalmologic medical care in rural areas. The article for the period 2011 - 2015 years, the analysis of volumes and financial security in system of obligatory medical insurance of the Leningrad region specialized ophthalmologic medical care rendered to patients with cataracts.

The study showed that in 2011, the surgical treatment of cataract was carried out with a small rate - 152 per 100 thousand population, and the waiting time for treatment was more than three years.

After the region of reforming of the health system modernization, including equipment ophthalmic departments of hospitals with modern medical equipment and training in its use ophthalmologists, scope and financing of specialized medical care has increased significantly, 93.7 per cent of operations have to be performed phacoemulsification. The number of operations in 2015 has increased to 269 per 100 thousand population, which required funding in the amount of 75992,9 RUB. (growth in comparison with 2011 by 696,2 %). Ensuring economic accessibility of health care after the modernization of health care has reduced the waiting period for cataract surgery in 79.4% of cases up to 1 month from the date of determination of indications
