The article deals with the problems associated with the definition of information intermediaries, the establishment of their role in the suppression and prevention of violations of intellectual rights, as well as the characteristics of cases and conditions of release of information intermediaries from liability for such violations.

The article substantiates the conclusion that the legislative provisions relating to information intermediaries should ensure not only the adoption of necessary and sufficient measures to stop the violation of intellectual property rights, but also compensation for damages caused to the right holders as a result of such violations. The author points out that the most complete compensation of damages caused to the right holders should be one of the main objectives of the further development of legal regulation in this area.

The author notes that the product of the functioning of the educational services is an educational service, which possesses a number of properties common to the service and educational properties specific to it, as well as such components as the buyer, producer (seller) and government regulation.
