This article is devoted to the study of the definition and signs of trust from a legal point of view. Interest in trust as a legal category arose not so long ago, therefore this phenomenon is poorly studied in this sense. Most of the work is devoted to exploring ways to increase confidence in law and the state, the relationship between such concepts as trust and distrust, and issues of trust in justice. Meanwhile, in our opinion, the category of “trust” is one of the most important in the theory of state and law, respectively, a one-sided approach to studying it can leave gaps, which will not allow the applied legal sciences to solve those problems in one way or another the trust.
