The article reviews the main activities of ESCWA in assisting Arab countries in building national policies that take into account the interests of persons with disabilities. The problem of protecting the rights of persons with disabilities is relevant for countries in any region. But in the countries of Western Asia, as the article shows, it is especially acute. The scientific novelty of this paper is the lack of research that touches upon regional experiences of cooperation on disability issues. Using a formal legal method,

the work analyses ESCWA's unique experience in improving regional disability statistics, as well as other activities that help Arab states to incorporate the social model of disability into national standards of social policy. The study concludes that ESCWA's role in promoting international standards on the rights of persons with disabilities in national policies in the region has increased.
